



Intellectual Property Guideline

This Guideline is intended to govern the use of the Kamloops Makerspace's brand, name, reputation, materials, logos, etc. Our aim is to ensure the use of our intellectual property for the benefit of our organization and its members.

Makerspace IP is to be used in the sole interest of the Makerspace and its members. No director, member or other individual may benefit personally or professionally from the creation, remix or use of Makerspace I.P. This includes actual or perceived conflicts of interest.

IP becomes the property of the Makerspace to be directed by current and future boards as per this and other applicable guidelines. The Kamloops Makerspace society retains ownership of materials bearing its name or likeness or affiliated materials.

Members and volunteers may create, remix and utilise Makerspace I.P. subject to the following conditions.

- a) Property created is freely available for Makerspace use as per this guideline.
- b) Files will be provided to all members freely in a usable and editable form.
- c) Creation or remix of I.P. does not imply any relationship monetary or otherwise with the Makerspace.
- d) Is not used in a promotional or commercial fashion.
- e) Is not used in a defamatory, offensive or illegal way.
- f) Does not imply any type of relationship with Kamloops Makerspace.

The Board of the Kamloops Makerspace Society may allow the use of material contrary to the above terms if given in writing and is in the best interest of the membership.

Intellectual property not bearing Kamloops Makerspace's brand, name, reputation, materials, logos, etc. Created at the Makerspace or using its resources is the property of its author alone.

Use of Kamloops Makerspace IP for workshops must be pre-approved by the board and may be subject to additional guidelines.
